

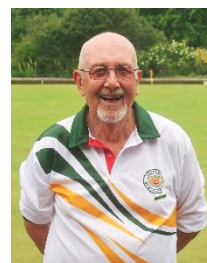

I HEARD IT ON THE GREEN

While it has become common practice for players to be given information about their last bowl after it has come to rest (eg. one yard short)... officially, 'possession of the rink will transfer to the opposing player or team, after allowing time for marking a toucher, as soon as it comes to rest.... A player must not deliver a bowl before the previous bowl comes to rest and possession of the rink has transferred....'. As a reminder, the Laws of the Sport of Bowls are available via the World Bowls website.
